SUBJECT: Public Health 4E071 Training

1. Recently many questions have been asked about how to upgrade Public Health 7 levels in lieu of the 7 level course cancellation. As the Public Health CFM, IAW AFI44-104, I wish to clarify these training questions.

a. Previously 7-level training was accomplished via in-residence training at the USAF School of Aerospace Medicine at Brooks AFB, Texas. This course was deleted earlier this year. The upgrading requirements for 7-level Public Health personnel will be changed to the completion of the following distance learning and in-residence courses:

(1) In-Residence: Public Health CONOPS course (B3OZYCONOP-000).

(2) *Distance Learning:*

i. Centers for Disease Control Principles of Epidemiology Course
(administered by either CDC or USAFSAM)

ii. Food Safety Course (administered by USAFSAM)

iii. Operational Entomology Course (either USAFSAM in-residence course or CDC Vector borne Disease Control Course administered by USAFSAM or CDC)

iv. Office Management Course (administered by USAFSAM possibly through Learn Link Software)

These courses will become mandatory for upgrade to 7-level on or about 1 Oct 02. These changes will be reflected in the next version of the 4E0X1 CFETP.

b. Since the in-residence course was deleted and the new requirements do not take effect until Oct 02, the following guidelines should be used to properly upgrade PH personnel to the 7-skill level:

- (1) The trainee is a SSgt (includes having a line number for SSgt) or above, and
- (2) The trainee has been in OJT for 12 months, and
- (3) The trainee has been trained and certified as knowing and can perform all core tasks identified in the CFETP under the requirements for 7-skill level
- (4) The trainee's training records are complete.
- (5) The supervisor recommends upgrade and Commander agrees

2. The CFETP requirement in table 8.2 for a "Trainer must be ALS graduate" is waived and local management will ensure compliance for "Trainers" and "Certifiers" IAW USAF Training guidelines.

3. In the interim time between the previous in-residence course and the new requirements taking effect, it is highly encouraged to send your personnel to the in-residence courses (CONOPS, Operational Entomology, Applied Epidemiology and Population Health Epidemiology Courses at USAFSAM). This will help ensure they have the desired skill sets to effectively accomplish our mission.
