AF Anthrax Implementation Plan

Are you using the correct Typhoid vaccine?

The only 2 authorized typhoid vaccines are:

6505-01-385-6328 Typhoid vaccine, modified acellular, 10ml, 20 dose

6505-01-324-6964, Typhoid vaccine, live capsules, Ty21A, 4's (Currently under an import band but safe to use remaining stock)

USAF Academy to do Regional Training

Starting in early 00 the USAF Academy will be authorized to accomplish refresher training. (IAW AFI 44-102) The catchment area will be the bases with in a 1-day drive. It will be also be available as a case by case option for bases outside this area. I will publish the details in October's newsletter. This does not constitute a shift in regions. Wilford Hall will still remain the regional facility.

There is a glitch in the code I wrote. Netscape seems to be allergic to this glitch. The USAF Immunization Web page is best viewed with Microsoft Explorer.


