J-Vax for Kadena

What should you do for your people leaving for Kadena? From the OIC of Clinical Disease Prevention Element & Immunization Element, Capt Pauline M. Lucas "JE is endemic north of the base and all incoming personnel are briefed on JE, told how to avoid mosquitoes while outdoors (camping etc,) and offered the vaccine. It is not mandatory for all AF, but is for Marines... We do provide the vaccine to dependents when requested." Bottom line, the vaccine is not required for entry into Okinawa, and is available at Kadena. (They do have a great patient education Tri-Fold, [available upon request](#))
