SUBJECT: Medical Standards Bridge Course (MSBC) Welcome

1. Welcome to Brooks City-Base and the USAF School of Aerospace Medicine. The instructor staff is looking forward to meeting you and beginning your indoctrination into the exciting world of **“Medical Standards.”** Class will begin **promptly at 0730 hours, on 19 July 04. Report NLT 0730 hours, to room W144 in building 775, Lyster Hall.**

2. As of 6 July 04, you are billeted off base at the The American Heritage Inn off of Military Highway. If you registered after 6 July, you may be billeted at a different location. The billeting office's number is DSN: 240-1844/Comm: (210) 536-1844. A base shuttle is available for transportation from the local hotels and billeting. It picks up at the hotels prior to its 0645 pick-up at billeting, and departs the schoolhouse at 1630 hrs Monday through Friday. Billeting will know exact hotel departure times. If you are driving, we encourage car-pooling and recommend arriving early due to limited parking. We have an entry control point at the main entrance (parking lot side of the school); doors open at 0700 hrs. Please be sure you have your ID card.

3. Students with current Hearing Conservation Certification not expiring within the next year will graduate on 27 Jul 04. Please do not make any travel arrangements prior to 1600 that day.

4. It is mandatory that all students adhere to **AFI 36-2903 standards.** Standard duty uniform is any combination of the **blue service uniform** for the duration of the course. The Service Dress Uniform is not needed for the course.

5. Please bring **2 copies of your orders, a copy of your itinerary** and a pen/pencil to class for in-processing. A set of note taking handouts and reference material will be provided to you throughout the course. Additionally, you will be provided with a personal copy of AFI 48-123 & AFPAM 48-133, so feel free to bring highlighters, post-it notes, or other items to customize your publications for easy referencing.

6. We are very proud of the reputation that the School of Aerospace Medicine has earned. The Force Health Management instructor staff is excited you are here, and we look forward to working with you throughout the ten-day course.
